

Support for Restaurants After a Natural Disaster

Relief Funds from DOORDASH

Relief funds are available to restaurants affected by the recent floods across Connecticut.

Restaurants across that state that meet certain criteria are eligible to apply for the DoorDash Restaurant Disaster Relief Fund. Grants can be used to cover expenses directly related to an eligible disaster such as flooding.

Criteria includes:

- Must have a brick & mortar location
- No more than three total locations
- 50 or fewer employees per location
- Been open for at least six months
- Revenues of \$3M or less per location in the last 12 months

Applications must be submitted within 12 months of the declared disaster. COVID-19 related damages are not eligible or considered by this fund. [Click here](#) or the button below to apply and for more details. Summer deadline is September 3, 2024.
