This morning, Governor Lamont signed and released Executive Order 11F “Protection of Public Health and Safety During Covid-19 Pandemic-Remote DMV Credentials, Outdoor Alcohol Service”.

Here is the relevant section (see below)

Service of Alcohol Without Food Permitted Effective May 1, 2021.

Effective May 1, 2021, the provisions of Executive Order No. 11B, Section 4 providing that “any indoor or outdoor on-premise service of alcoholic liquor is limited to when a patron is consuming food prepared on the premise” shall apply only indoors, and therefore, service of alcohol outdoors without the sale or consumption of food may resume and the presence and use of consumer bars for the outdoor consumption of alcohol is no longer prohibited.
